Join in for a special creative printmaking workshop designed to help explore the art of TetraPak printmaking. We will use recycled TetraPak cartons for intaglio etching plates in which the focus will be on etching, scoring, and peeling the foil liner to form a design. From there we will continue with learning how to ink the plate, and transfer the image on printmaking paper with a roller press.

This eco-friendly technique creates rich textures, high contrast, and beautiful prints without using traditional chemicals or hazardous materials. This is a resourceful and enjoyable art form that allows for individual creative expression.

Participants will make a 5"x7" print on 6"x8" BFK Rives printmaking paper. All are encouraged to bring their own inspiration or drawing for making a print.

Additional supply options for participants: Sketchbook with drawing, tracing paper, pencil, tetraPak carton, X-acto knife, Q-tips, etching tool or metal tip pencil, expired credit card or similar, scissors
